Dr. Sat Paul Sharma, appellant filed RTI application dated 19.11.2019 and sought some information from the PIO, O/o Municipal Corporation, Patiala. When no information was provided to him by the PIO, then he filed First Appeal before the First Appellate Authority on 24.12.2019. Then he filed Second Appeal before the Punjab State Information Commission on 11.02.2020. The case was registered and allocated to the Bench.
