3. The respondent submits that the sought information as available on record has already been sent to the appellant through registered post and also submits a copy of reply alongwith a copy of postal receipt, which is taken on record.

4. The appellant is absent without any intimation, which seems that his absence from the Commission is intentional and willful. It is also a fact on record that notice of hearing was sent to the appellant through registered post and even though the appellant is absent without intimation, which appears that he has received the information and is satisfied with the same and does not want to pursue this case.
