Then he filed Second Appeal before the Punjab State Information Commission on 16.01.2020. The case was registered and allocated to the Bench. Notice of hearing was issued to both the parties for today.

Both the parties are present today. I have gone through the RTI application dated 24.09.2019 and also discussed the matter with both the parties.

The Commission has received a mail sent by the PIO on 04.03.2020, diarized vide no.4309, which is a copy of letter no.12443 dated 25.02.2020 along with attested copies of information comprising of 577 pages as was sought by the appellant.

The attested copies of 577 pages of information, which was sent to the Commission by the PIO, has been provided to the appellant today before the Commission. The appellant has gone through the information and he stated that he is satisfied with the information. He has submitted a duly signed written submission dated 05.03.2020 that he has received the sought for information and he is satisfied and also requested to dispose of his appeal case.

As the sought for information has been provided to the appellant by the PIO and the appellant is satisfied, so the present appeal case is **disposed of and closed**.
