4. The perusal of the case file shows that the appellant had sent a written submission through email dated 17.08.2023 regarding public interest for seeking third party information, as he was directed vide order dated 25.07.2023, which is not justified. Accordingly, he was again directed to submit the same on hearing held on 14.03.2024 but he has failed to avail the given opportunities. As the appellant absent for consecutively two hearings without any intimation, which seems that he is not serious to pursue his case as well as absence of appellant prime facie seems intentional and wilful, which is not sustainable.

5. In wake of above, no further cause of action is required in this case. Hence, the case is **disposed of & closed**.
