- 2. The appellant has sent deficiencies in the information vide his letter dated 14.12.2019 but no response to that has been received by him from BDPO, Machhiwara.
- 3. Last opportunity is afforded to the respondent-BDPO, Machhiwara to supply remaining information according to his original application for seeking information to the appellant with a copy to the Commission before the next date of hearing failing which punitive action will be initiated on the next date of hearing.
- 4. To come up on 28.1.2020 at 3.00 P.M. to be heard through Video Conference Facility available in the office of the Deputy Commission, Ludhiana.
