
3. The appellant has gone through the same and is not satisfied. The respondent further states that the appellant can inspect the record today itself and obtain the information.

2. Today the appellant is not present. She has sent consent of third party who is father of the appellant through mail. The same is taken on record.


3. Respondent states that he has not received consent of third party, but he has brought the information today in the Commission.
