I have gone through the RTI application dated 03.10.2018 and also gone through the previous Orders passed by the Bench, which are in the file of the Commission. The PIO has provided attested copies of 920 pages of information to the appellant through letter no. 296 dated 24.04.2019. The appellant was satisfied with the information provided to her by the PIO except some information related with para nos.4, 7 and 13 of the RTI application.

The appellant visited the office of the PIO on 06.09.2019 and after making the inspection 11 pages of information were provided to the appellant and she executed a certificate dated 06.09.2019 duly signed by her. The Respondent has submitted a copy of the said certificate along with a copy of letter no. 2061 dated 09.09.2019 to the Bench, which are taken in the file of the Commission. A copy of letter no.2061 dated 09.09.2019 is handed over to the appellant today before the Bench.

I have gone through the copy of letter no. 2061 dated 09.09.2019. Specific reply has been submitted by the PIO regarding the remaining information related with para nos. 4, 7 and 13 of the RTI application. It is submitted in the letter by the PIO that the information which was available in the office of the PIO had already been provided to the appellant and except that no other information is available in the office of the PIO.

As per the reply dated 09.09.2019 submitted by the PIO that information which was available in the office of the PIO had already been provided to the appellant and except that no other information is available in the office of the PIO, so she unable to provide it to the appellant.

So, I am of the view that 920 attested pages of information had already been provided to the appellant and attested copies of 11 more pages were provided to her on 06.09.2019 and except this information no other information is available in the office of the PIO. So, the PIO has resolved the matter involved in the RTI application and provided the information to the appellant.

A Show Cause Notice was issued to the PIO, Smt. Pallavi Chhabra on 26.06.2019 that why you have not provided the complete information to the appellant and so why you may not be penalized under the provisions of the RTI Act, 2005.

On the last date of hearing the PIO filed a reply to the Show Cause Notice through letter no. 1795 dated 16.08.2019 along with a self attested affidavit dated 22.08.2019.

The Show Cause Notice was issued to Smt. Pallavi Chhabra, PIO on 26.06.2019. The major information sought by the appellant was provided to her by the PIO through letter no.296 dated 24.04.2019 before the issuance of the Show Cause Notice. The PIO was not present on 26.06.2019 and a Show Cause Notice was issued to her. She submitted in the reply that she was on earned leave from 06.06.2019 to 12.07.2019 and that was the reason that she could not appear before the Commission on 26.06.2019. The reply of the PIO is genuine. So, the Show Cause Notice issued to her is hereby dropped and filed.

As the information had already been provided to the appellant by the office of the PIO and except that no other information is available in the office of the PIO as per the reply submitted by the PIO vide letter no.2061 dated 09.09.2019, so the present appeal case is **disposed of and closed.**
