#### **ORDER**

This order may be read with reference to the previous order dated 05.11.2020.

- 2. Today neither the complainant nor the respondent is present. The perusal of the file shows that the respondent has sent point-wise reply to the commission office through mail. Copy of the same is taken on record.
- 3. After going through the file, it is observed that this is the complaint case and there is the judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India rendered dated 12.12.2011 in Civil Appeal Nos. Nos.10787 10788 of 2011 (arising out of SLP © No.32768-32769/2010)- Chief Information Commissioner and another Vs. State of Manipur and another, in Para 31 whereof, it has been held that while entertaining a complaint case under Section 18 of the RTI Act , 2005, the Commissioners have no jurisdiction to pass an order providing for an access to the information which is as under:-
  - (31. We uphold the said contention and do not find any error in the impugned judgment of the High Court whereby it has been held that the Commissioner while entertaining a complaint under Section 18 of the said Act has no jurisdiction to pass an order providing for access to the information).

As such, since the complainant has approached the Commission under the provision of Section 18 of the RTI Act, 2005, no directions for providing further information can be given by the Commission.

4. Since there is an alternative and efficacious remedy of first appeal available to the Complainant under Section 19(1) of the RTI Act, 2005, which has not been availed in the instant case and the First Appellate Authority has not had the occasion to review the decision of the PIO, as envisaged under the RTI Act by passing a detailed well-reasoned

speaking order. - 5. If, however, the complainant does not feel satisfied with the decision of the First Appellate Authority, he will be at liberty to file a Second Appeal before the Commission under Section 19(3) of the RTI Act, 2005.
- 6. In view of the observations noted above, the instant case is **disposed of.** Copies of this decision be sent to the parties *through registered post.*


