ORDER

The respondent stated that the information was sent to the appellant through letter no.1330 dated 06.03.2020 and submitted a copy of the said letter along with a copy of letter no.6709 dated 11.11.2020 and attested copies of information.

The appellant remained absent on the last date of hearing.

I have gone through letter no.1330 dated 06.03.2020 through which the information was sent to the appellant and also gone through letter no.6709 dated 11.11.2020.

A Show Cause Notice was issued to the SPIO on the last date of hearing i.e. 13.10.2020. The SPIO submitted unconditional apology and assured the Commission that in future, the sought for information would be provided to the information seekers within the stipulated period and also requested to drop the Show Cause Notice.

As the respondent has submitted unconditional apology and the information had already been sent to the appellant on 06.03.2020, but the Show Cause Notice was issued to the SPIO on 13.10.2020, so the Show Cause Notice issued to the SPIO is hereby dropped and filed.

Appeal Case No. 275 of 2020

The information was sent to the appellant vide letter no.1330 dated 06.03.2020. The appellant requested that once again the attested copy of information be sent to him.

So, the SPIO is directed that once again the attested copy of information be sent to the appellant through registered post within 2 days and compliance report be sent back to the commission.

Shri Bittu, appellant filed RTI application dated 17.08.2020 and sought some information from the SPIO, O/o Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana. When no information was provided to him by the SPIO then he filed First Appeal before the First Appellate Authority on 24.08.2020 and then Second Appeal before the Punjab State Information Commission on 10.09.2020. The case was registered and allocated to the Bench. Notice of hearing was issued to both the parties for today **through CISCO Webex Meetings Software.**

Both the parties are present today. The respondent, who is present on behalf of the SPIO, stated that the inquiry/investigation regarding the information sought by the appellant is still under process and regarding this the reply has been sent to the Commission vide letter no.654/D dated 12.11.2020 and a copy of the same has been sent to the appellant.

I have gone through letter no.654/D dated 12.11.2020 sent by the SPIO-cum-DCP, Ludhiana and it is submitted by the SPIO that the office of the DGP, Punjab has sent the RTI application dated 17.08.2020 filed by the appellant to his office which was received on 09.11.2020. O R D E R

Shri Nitin Kumar Garg, appellant filed RTI application dated 22.01.2020 and sought some information from the SPIO, O/o Civil Surgeon, Ludhiana. When no information was provided to the appellant by the SPIO then he filed First Appeal before the First Appellate Authority on 01.06.2020 and then Second Appeal before the Punjab State Information Commission on 03.09.2020. The case was registered and allocated to the Bench. Notice of hearing was issued to both the parties for today **through CISCO Webex Meetings Software.**

Both the parties are present today.

The SPIO stated that the information sought by the appellant is related with different branches and the appellant was asked to deposit the assessed fee of Rs.5662/- with the office of the SPIO vide letter no.117 dated 29.01.2020, but the appellant has not deposited the assessed fee with the office of the SPIO till today.

The appellant filed RTI application on 22.01.2020 and the SPIO wrote letter no.117 dated 29.01.2020 to the appellant and asked him to deposit the amount of assessed fee with the office of the SPIO, but the appellant has not deposited the assessed fee.

So, the present appeal case is disposed of and closed with the observation that in case the appellant wants to get the information then he should deposit the assessed fee of Rs.5662/- with the office of the SPIO within 10 days and the SPIO is further directed that in case the appellant would deposit the amount of assessed fee, then he should provide the attested copies of sought for information to the appellant within a week from the deposit of assessed fee.

With this observation the present appeal case is **disposed of and closed.**
