First appeal was filed with the First Appellate Authority (hereinafter called FAA) on 15.12.2019 and second appeal was filed in the Commission on 11.02.2019 under Section 19 of the Right to Information Act, 2005 (hereinafter called RTI Act). Notice of hearing was issued to the parties for today.

- 2. The appellant states that he has filed same two 2^{nd} appeals in the Commission, one by post and another though an e-mail. The Commission has prepared two 2^{nd} appeals bearing numbers 644 and 705/2020 seeking the same information.
