

# ORDER

This order may be read with reference to the previous order dated 29.9.2020.

2. The representative of the respondents states that the complete information has already been provided to the appellant vide No. 6671 dated 15.9.2020 and a letter bearing No. 6734 dated 13.11.2020 is written by the Municipal Corporation, District Ludhiana in this regard is taken on record.

3. In the letter dated 13.11.2020 written by the respondents it has mentioned that the orders of the Commission dated 29.9.2020 has been received by the Health officer through whatsapp on 12.11.2020. But later on, the Health officer states that the said orders of the Commission has been received from the Superintendent of the Municipal Corporation, District Ludhiana.

## ORDER

This order may be read with reference to the previous order dated 7.10.2020.

2. The appellant states that no information has been provided by the respondents so far. The respondent-Public Information Officer states that he has joined as Panchayat Secretary and is the Public Information Officer in this case. He also assured that the information pertaining to the RTI application will be supplied to the appellant.

3. A show cause notice was issued to Shri Kiranpal Singh, Panchayat Secretary-cum-Public Information Officer neither he supplied the information nor any submission/reply has been received from him. A copy of the letter bearing No. 3755 dated 5.11.2020 of the Block Development and Panchayats Officer, Ludhiana -1 is received in the Commission, which is taken on record, vide which Sh. Kiranpal Singh, Panchayat Secretary has been informed telephonically about the today's hearing in this case. Even though Sh. Kiranpal remained absent.

4. The perusal of the file and the conduct of the respondent-PIO compelled the Commission to issue him a formal show cause notice on 07.10.2019 as to why action under Section 20(1) of the RTI Act 2005 should not be taken against him and he was also provided an opportunity to file his written reply and also make use of opportunity of personal hearing under the principles of natural justice.

5. Since the responsibility to ensure timely transmission of the information to the appellant lies on the PIO, Shri Kiranpal Singh, Panchayat Secretary o/o Block Development

and Panchayats Officer, Ludhiana-1 is hereby held guilty for not providing the information on time as prescribed under Section 7 of the RTI Act, 2005, which is within 30 days of the receipt of the request for supply of information and for repeated and wilful defiance of the Punjab State Information Commission's orders.

6. Such kind of failure on the part of the respondent-PIO is totally unacceptable. It is pertinent to mention here that RTI Act has been enacted to ensure participative nature of management between the public & the public authorities and also to know as to what is happening behind the closed doors with regard to the governance affairs of the public authorities and their functioning.

7. After giving thoughtful consideration and due perusal of the facts of the case and the material available on record, I have come to the conclusion that he has failed to perform his duty as per the mandate of the RTI Act, which requires the public servant to ensure due transparency and accountability in its functioning. It has also come out that he has not only failed to perform his duty at his own level but also has shown his casual approach in complying with the explicit order of the Commission.

8. It has been further established from his conduct that he has failed to provide the information even after getting formal show cause notice from the Commission. This speaks volumes as to how much respect & regard he has in his mind to the provisions of the RTI Act, which mandates that all public authorities will ensure that the RTI Act, 2005 is duly implemented by them, whenever any citizen approaches the public authority to get any public information for which they have right to ask for as per the provisions of RTI Act. In view of the facts mentioned herein, I am of the considered view that PIO, Shri Kiranpal Singh, Panchayat Secretary o/o Block Development and Panchayats Officer, Ludhiana-1 should be penalised for his negligence in discharge of his statutory duty prescribed under the RTI Act. All his failure make me believe that his sheer neglect to perform his duties will be met only after he is duly taken to task as per the provisions of the RTI Act i.e. Section 20(1), which provides that any delay on the part of the respondent-PIO beyond 30 days is to be penalized @ 250/- per day and to the maximum of Rs. 25000/-

9. Under these circumstances, I am left with no other option but to decide the question of imposition of penalty and quantum thereof upon PIO, Shri Kiranpal Singh, Panchayat Secretary o/o Block Development and Panchayats Officer, Ludhiana-1 as per the provisions of the RTI Act i.e. Section 20(1) of the RTI Act, 2005. In this case the intervening period is too large, the respondent-PIO failed to comply with the orders of the Commission. Accordingly, a penalty of Rs. 5000/- (Rupees Five thousand only) is imposed on him.

10. The amount of penalty i.e. Rs. 5000/- (Rupees Five thousand only) should be deducted from his salary in two installments and be deposited in the Government treasury under head "0070-Other Administrative Services-60-Other Services-800-Other Receipts-86-Fees under the Right to Information Act. The District Development and Panchayats Officer/Block Development and

Panchayats Officer concerned shall ensure that this amount of penalty is deducted from the salary of the above said defaulting official for the month of November, 20120 and December, 2020 and deposited in the Treasury under the relevant head and sent compliance report to the Commission on or before 20.01.2021.

11. Further the Commission is of the view that since the appellant has had to suffer undue inconvenience to get the information, it is a fit case for awarding compensation to the appellant under Section 19(8)(b) of the RTI Act.

12. PIO, Shri Kiranpal Singh, Panchayat Secretary o/o Block Development and Panchayats Officer, Ludhiana-1 is directed to pay an amount of Rs.10000/- (Rupees Ten thousand only) via demand draft drawn through Government Treasury (to be paid by the office from the State Exchequer) as compensation to the appellant for the loss and detriment suffered by him of having to file the appeals and not getting the information in time. The PIO is directed to duly inform the Commission of the compliance of the order and submit proof of having compensated the appellant.

13. The present respondent-PIO is directed to intimate the appellant after taking appropriate action on the application dated 04.12.2019 for seeking information with a copy to the Commission before the next date of hearing as per the assurance given by him failing which the penalty provisions will be invoked on the next date of hearing.
