### ORDER

This order may be read with reference to the previous order dated 19.8.2019 vide which the appellant was advised to inform the Commission where the Tehsildar, Ajnala has mentioned the way of 5 karmas in his affidavit filed in the Hon'ble Punjab and Haryana High Court, Chandigarh through e-mail to the Commission with a copy to the respondents within seven days from its receipt.

2. The appellant has sent an email dated 2.9.2019 and letter dated 2.9.2019 received in the Commission on 10.9.2019 which has been taken on record.
