This order may be read with reference to the previous order dated 26.02.2020 vide which last opportunity was afforded to the appellant to send citation for supply of personal information of third party before the next date of hearing failing which the case will be decided on the merits of the case. After receipt of citation from the appellant, the respondents are directed to take action and intimate the appellant regarding action taken with a copy to the Commission.

2. In compliance to the previous order, the appellant has sent clipping of Times of India in which it is published in reference to the order of Central Information Commission that service book of an employee can be assessed by a third party. He also quoted three citations of Punjab and Haryana High Court in CWP No.17758 date of decision 19.05.2016 and Hon'ble Himachal Pradesh High Court (DB) in CWP No. 640 of 2012 decided on 24.08.2012 and another case judgment of Hon'ble Punjab and Haryana High Court in CWP No.17718 of 2014.

3. After hearing the parties and going through the record available on the case file, it is revealed that in the order of Central Information Commission it is mentioned that service book of an employee can be assessed by third party, if the information sought by the information-seeker is in public interest or in corruption case. However, the appellant has failed to establish any larger public interest in seeking the information. He also quoted judgments of Punjab and Haryana High Court in CWP No.17758 , date of decision 19.05.2016 and Hon'ble Himachal

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Pradesh High Court (DB) in CWP No. 640 of 2012 decided on 24.08.2012 in which it is mentioned that if once the delay is established then penalty must be imposed on the respondent-PIO. After perusing the record, it is ascertained that the appellant has not mentioned date on his own RTI application for seeking information, which was sent to the Deputy Commissioner's office. However, the date of application for seeking information has been determined from the receipt given by the postal authority i.e. 21.08.2019. The Commission is of the view that registered letter of 21.08.2019 was delivered to Deputy Commissioner's office after few days from its dispatch. Considering the number of working days, the PIO has not committed any violation of the Right to Information Act, 2005 in transferring the application to the concerned PIO. The application dated 21.08.2019 was transferred to the Officer Incharge/Sadar Kanugo Branch, Amritsar on 05.09.2019 and they have sent reply to the appellant on 30.9.2019, which is within stipulated period under the provisions of RTI Act, 2005. It is pertinent to mention here that the citation CWP No.17718 quoted by appellant is not relevant to the present case as it envisages that the complete information should be supplied in corruption cases. The Hon'ble Apex Court in Civil Appeal No. 22 of 2009 titled as Canara Bank vs. C.S. Shyam and another, Girish Ramchandra Deshpande Vs. Central Information Commissioner and Ors reported as (2013)1 SCC 212 and R.K. Jain vs. Union of India and another reported as (2013) 14 SCC 794 has held that " It is for the reasons, that firstly, the information sought by respondent No.1 of individual employees working in the Bank was personal in nature; secondly, it was exempted from being disclosed under Section 8(j) of the Act and lastly neither respondent No.1 disclosed any public interest much less larger public interest involved in seeking such information of the individual employee." The information regarding points at Sr. Nos. 2 and 3 has already been supplied to the appellant to his satisfaction and information concerning points at Sr. No.1 and 4 has been denied because the appellant failed to establish any larger public interest. Hence the present case is disposed of and closed. Copies of the order be sent to the parties.
