to the Commission, which is a copy of letter no.60037 dated 17.09.2020. I have gone through
the said letter and it is submitted by the SPIO that he is unable to appear for today's hearing as

I have gone through the mail sent by the SPIO, which was received in the office of the Commission on 01.09.2020, diarized vide no.10969 and is a copy of letter no.60025/RTI dated 25.08.2020. The information which has already been provided to the appellant in Appeal Case no.3697 of 2019 has been mentioned in this letter and extra to that information the other information sought by the appellant through para no.2 of the RTI application for the period 01.01.2019 to 31.03.2019 regarding the booking of 'Rumala Sahib' and 'Chandoa Sahib', the attested copies of information has been sent to the appellant.
