**O R D E R**

Shri Jasbir Singh, appellant filed RTI application dated 14.12.2019 and sought some information from the PIO, O/o ADGP (Crime), PB. Chandigarh.

**Today the case is heard through CISCO Webex Meetings Software.**

The appellant is absent today, whereas ASI Ramesh Kumar is present on behalf of the SPIO, O/o Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana and he stated that the inquiry in this case is still pending and as soon as the inquiry would be completed the sought for information would be given to the appellant. He further stated that the reply regarding this has been sent to the Commission vide letter no.2083/20 dated 10.11.2020.

I have gone through letter no.2083/20 dated 10.11.2020 and it is submitted by the SPIO that the inquiry/investigation regarding the information sought by the appellant is still under process before the I/C Technical Sport Unit, Ludhiana and hence the information cannot be provide to the appellant U/s 8(1)(h) of the RTI Act, 2005. It is further submitted by the SPIO that the appellant has been informed regarding this vide letter no.542 dated 05.10.2020.

So as per the reply submitted by the SPIO that the inquiry/investigation regarding the information sought by the appellant is still under process, so the information cannot be provided to the appellant U/s 8(1)(h) of the RTI Act, 2005. Hence the present appeal case is **disposed of and closed** with a direction to the SPIO that whenever the concerned inquiry/investigation would be completed, the attested copies of sought for information be sent to the appellant through registered post within 15 days and compliance report be sent to the Commission.

**O R D E R**

Shri Tejinder Singh, Advocate, appellant filed RTI application dated 18.05.2020 and sought some information from the PIO, O/o Distt. Program Officer, Social Security and Welfare Deptt. Ludhiana. When no information was provided to him by the SPIO then he filed First Appeal before the First Appellate Authority on 21.06.2020. Then he filed Second Appeal before the Punjab State Information Commission on 03.09.2020. The case was registered and allocated to the Bench. Notice of hearing was issued to both the parties for today to be heard through **CISCO Webex Meetings Software**.

The appellant is absent today, whereas the SPIO has come present.

The appellant has sent an e-mail to the Commission and submitted that he is unable to appear before the Commission for today.

The SPIO stated that the reply was sent to the appellant vide letter no.9784 dated 26.06.2020 and it was submitted that due to COVID-19 the all the Aanganwadi centres have been closed by the Govt., so the information cannot be provided. He further stated that letter no.2511 dated 08.10.2020 was sent to the appellant and he was asked to deposit the assessed amount of Rs.15,73,878/- with the office of the SPIO, so that the photocopies of sought for information be provided to him. He further stated that the appellant has not deposited the assessed fee with the office of the SPIO till today.

**Appeal Case No. 2445 of 2020**

The Commission has received an e-mail sent by the SPIO, which is a copy of letter no.2511 dated 08.10.2020 along with copy of letter no. 2512 dated 08.10.2020. I have gone through the said letters.

The SPIO wrote letter no. 2511 dated 08.10.2020 to the appellant and asked him to deposit the amount of assessed fee of Rs.15,73,878/-with the office of the SPIO, but the appellant has not deposited the assessed fee.

So, the present appeal case is disposed of and closed with the observation that in case the appellant wants to get the information then he should deposit the assessed fee of Rs.15,73,878/- with the office of the SPIO within 20 days and the SPIO is further directed that in case the appellant would deposit the amount of assessed fee, then he should provide the attested copies of sought for information to the appellant within 10 days from the deposit of assessed fee.

With this observation the present appeal case is **disposed of and closed**.
