When no information was provided to him by the SPIO, then he filed First Appeal before the First Appellate Authority on 06.08.2020 and then filed Second Appeal before the Punjab State Information Commission on 14.10.2020. The case was registered and allocated to the Bench. Notice of hearing was issued to both the parties for today **through CISCO Webex Meetings Software.**

The appellant is present and Advocate Munish Kapila is present on behalf of the SPIO, O/o Asstt. Manager, Human Resources, Health Care H.R. Department, Palana Care, Fortis Hospital, Mohali.

The counsel of the respondent stated that the Fortis Hospital, Mohali is a private institution and it does not come within the ambit of definition of public authority as defined U/s 2(h) of the RTI Act, 2005. He further submitted that the respondent Fortis Hospital is a private body and is not getting any financial help from the Govt.

I am of the view that the Fortis Hospital, Mohali is a private body as it is not getting any financial help from the Govt. Therefore, the Right to Information Act does not apply to the respondent Fortis Hospital, Mohali. So, no RTI application lies. Hence, the present appeal case is **disposed of and closed.**

The appellant stated that complete information has not been provided to him by the SPIO.

The Commission has received a mail sent by the SPIO on 07.12.2020, diarized vide no.17780, which is a copy of letter no.1311-12 dated 21.11.2020 along with a copy of letter no.301 dated 29.06.2020 and copy of letter no.601 dated 04.08.2020.

I have gone through letter no.1311-12 dated 21.11.2020 and it is submitted by the SPIO that vide his RTI application the appellant sought information through 10 points and the information comprising of 75 pages regarding point nos.1 and 3 of the RTI application has been sent to the appellant. It is further submitted by the SPIO that the remaining information was denied U/s 8(1) of the RTI Act, 2005 being personal information.
