I have gone through all the documents. As the security wing of the Punjab Police has been kept out of purview of the RTI Act, 2005 vide notification dated 23.02.2006 and notification dated 07.06.2016, so the information cannot be provided to the applicant. Hence, the present complaint case is **disposed of and closed.**
