#### ORDER

Heard through facility of Software/application 'CISCO Webex Meetings'.

The RTI request is dated 21.09.2021 . First appeal is dated 21.10.2021. Second appeal has been received in the Commission on 07.02.2022.

On the last date of hearing, held on 22.06.2022 ;

- i) Sh. Amandeep Singh, Clerk, stated that the information at point no. 02, 03 and 04 of the RTI request was supplied to the appellant and information at point no 01, 05 and 06 relates with Panchayat Secretary, Gram Panchayat, Gurala.

It, alongwith a copy of acknowledgement -receipt, is taken on record.

The RTI request is dated 19.10.2021 . First appeal is dated 15.12.2021. Second  
appeal has been received in the Commission on 07.02.2022.

- i) Sh.
