ORDER

This order may be read with reference to the order dated 16.08.2023.

2. Earlier, the case was heard by Sh. Suresh Arora, Chief Information Commissioner, who has demitted the office on 25.09.2023. Thereafter the case was allocated to this Bench, which is fixed for hearing today i. e. 21.03.2024.

3. The appellant sought the following information as per the RTI application:

- I. Seniority List of Master/Mistress Cadre of Punjab.
- II. List of Teachers promoted who were appointed after 1998 in Master/Mistress Cadre till date. Kindly provide detail list of promotion along with their date of promotion.
- III. Whether seniority number is issued to Mrs. Amandeep Kaur, W/o Rajan Sarang who was appointed as Teacher in Master/Mistress Cadre on 27/07/1998. If yes, provide the seniority number.

4. Both the parties are absent without any intimation.

5. The perusal of the case file shows that information with regard to Point No. 1 had already been supplied to the appellant in the PDF format. Further, reply pertaining to Point No. 2 and 3 has already been sent to the appellant through ਮੀਮੇ ਨੰਬਰ 464707 File No: DPIS-EST20RTI/5/2023-ESTABLISHMENT-2-DPIS, the relevant portion of which is reproduced below:

2.0 ਅਪੀਲ ਕਰਤਾ ਦੀ ਬੇਨਤੀ ਨੂੰ ਧਿਆਨ ਵਿੱਚ ਰੱਖਦੇ ਹੋਏ ਸਿੱਖਿਆ ਵਿਭਾਗ, ਚੰਡੀਗੜ੍ਹ ਪ੍ਰਸ਼ਾਸਨ ਨੂੰ ਪੰਜਾਬ ਰਾਜ ਤੋਂ ਡੈਪੂਟੇਸ਼ਨ ਤੇ ਗਏ ਅਧਿਆਪਕਾਂ ਦੇ ਮਾਸਟਰ ਕਾਰਡ ਦੇ ਸੀਨੀਅਰਤਾ ਦੇ ਕੇਸ ਇਸ ਦਫਤਰ ਦੇ ਪੱਤਰ ਮਿਤੀ 31.07.2023 ਰਾਹੀਂ ਪੜ੍ਹਾਅ ਅਨੁਸਾਰ ਮੰਗੇ ਗਏ ਹਨ (ਪੱਤਰ ਨੰਬਰ)। ਮਿਤੀ 07.07.2023 ਨੂੰ ਮਾਨਯੋਗ ਰਾਜ ਸੂਚਨਾ ਕਮਿਸ਼ਨ ਦੇ ਹੁਕਮਾਂ ਅਨੁਸਾਰ ਇਹ ਸੂਚਿਤ ਕੀਤਾ ਜਾਂਦਾ ਹੈ ਕਿ ਵਿਭਾਗ ਵੱਲੋਂ ਮਾਸਟਰ ਕਾਰਡ ਦੀ ਸੀਨੀਅਰਤਾ ਮਿਤੀ 19.06.2019 (ਖਾਰਜ) ਵਿਭਾਗ ਦੀ ਵੈਬਸਾਈਟ www.ssapunjab.org ਤੇ ਮਿਤੀ 21.06.2019 ਨੂੰ ਅਪਲੋਡ ਕੀਤੀ ਗਈ ਸੀ, ਜੋ ਕਿ ਅੱਜ ਵੀ ਵੈਬ-ਸਾਈਟ ਤੇ ਉਪਲੱਬਧ ਹੈ।

4.0 ਅਪੀਲਕਰਤਾ ਨੂੰ ਆਪਣੇ ਮੁਕੰਮਲ ਵੇਰਵੇ ਦੀ ਮੁਕੰਮਲ ਸੂਚਨਾ ਰਿਕਾਰਡ ਅਨੁਸਾਰ ਉਕਤ ਪੱਤਰ ਅਨੁਸਾਰ ਯੋਗ ਪ੍ਰਣਾਲੀ ਰਾਹੀਂ ਭੇਜਣ।

6. After perusal of the RTI application viz a viz response filed by the respondent, as mentioned herein, the response of the respondent is accepted and the Commission is of the view that no further action is required to be taken in this case. Hence, this case is **disposed of & closed**.

7. However, the liberty is granted to the appellant to approach the Commission within four weeks, in case he has any submissions to make.
