Today at the time of hearing Shri Sham Lal, PIO has provided the copy of letter dated 25.07.2019 to the appellant.

Shri Sham Lal, PIO submitted before the Bench that he has been appointed as PIO during the last week. This fact is also mentioned in the e-mail sent by Shri Arvind Kumar, PCS, RTA, Patiala. But before that Shri Arvind Kumar, PCS, RTA, Patiala was the PIO since February, 2019. The present RTI application was filed on 24.05.2019. A period of 5 months has been passed, but no information has been provided to the appellant. The conduct of Shri Arvind Kumar, RTA, Patiala is condemnable. He has no respect for the law and towards his duties.

The conduct of Shri Arvind Kumar, PCS, RTA, Patiala amounts to denial of information and defiance of the provisions of the RTI Act, 2005. So, a Show Cause Notice is issued to Shri Arvind Kumar, PCS, RTA, Patiala that why you have not provided the information to the appellant within the stipulated period and so why you may not be penalized under the provisions of the RTI Act, 2005.

Shri Arvind Kumar, RTA, Patiala is directed that he should personally come present on the next date of hearing and file reply to the Show Cause Notice through duly attested affidavit and an opportunity of personal hearing will be afforded to him.

The appellant has gone through the information which is provided to him today and he stated that he is satisfied with the information related with para nos. 2 to 5 of the RTI application, but no information has been provided to him regarding para no.1 of the RTI application.

So, the PIO is directed that information related with para no.1 of the RTI application be sent to the appellant through registered post within a week.

In case the appellant would not contact the office of the PIO for inspection and would not personally come present before the Bench on the next date of hearing, then it will be assumed that the appellant is not interested in getting the information and the case will be decided as per the reply filed by the PIO.

The PIO has submitted a copy of letter no.4514 dated 15.10.2019, which is taken in the file of the Commission. It is submitted in the letter by the PIO that the appellant has not

complied with the Order of the Commission dated 30.09.2019 and he has not come present for making inspection of the record in the office of the PIO on 10.10.2019.

The appellant never come present before the Commission on any date of hearing and a clear cut direction was issued to the appellant on the last date of hearing to visit the office of the PIO for making inspection on 10.10.2019 and to come personally present before the Commission for today. Neither he went to the office of the PIO nor he has come present today for hearing before the Commission, whereas the PIO or his nominees used to come present on every date of hearing before the Commission. It seems that the appellant is not interested in getting the information.

So, the present appeal case is **disposed of and closed.**
