 - x. Kindly provide copy of affidavit/undertaking of contractors that they have not been declared defaulter or blacklisted throughout in Punjab.
 - xi. Certified copies of pending works and unpaid works done from the PUIEP Phase I and II grant.
 - xii. Certified copies of records of returning unused amount from the grants and the amount saved by doing discounted jobs by the contractors.
 - xiii. Certified details of completed and uncompleted job works from the PUIEP Phase I and II grants.

as enumerated in his RTI application from the PIO o/o **Deputy Secretary, PSPCL, Patiala**. When no information was received, the Complainant filed a complaint under Section 18 of the RTI Act, 2005 to the Commission on **5.10.2020**. The case was last heard on **14.1.2021**

2. This Complaint Case was Remanded Back to the First Appellant Authority vide Commission's Order Dated 14.1.2021, with the following directions:

“The Complainant Sushil Kumar stated that he had not been given the information requested despite the lapse of nearly 15 months. However, this was a Complaint Case and since the complainant had expressly stated that he wished to get the information as sought in his RTI application, this Commission deems it fit to Reverted this Complaint Case to the First Appellate Authority (FAA).

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Complaint Case No. 730 of 2020

Reverted to the FAA-cum-Chief Engineer (Technical), HRD, Punjab State Power Corporation Limited, Patiala with the direction that this be treated as a First Appeal and the complainant Sushil Kumar be granted an early hearing as per the provisions of the RTI Act, 2005.”

3. The Complaint is accordingly **Disposed of**.
