The request made by the appellant shows carelessness as he was well aware about the hearing of the case and he should have made a request by giving sufficient time which has not been given by the appellant to the respondent as well as to the Commission when he is well conversant with the law and know all intricacy of law so ignorance on his part is not justified specially when the respondent is present all the way from Amritsar alongwith the huge record. The respondent present Sh. Surinder Singh, A.S.I., submits that information sought has already been given to the appellant many times through registered post. Although each and every citizen has a right to act bonafidely to get the information but on the same time it is a duty of the Commission to prevent from the misuse of law.
- 3. In view of the specific order passed by the Commission, enumerated above, no response has been received from the appellant in this regard. In the interest of natural justice, one opportunity is granted to the appellant to make the submissions, if any, to take the matter to its logical end, failing which the decision will be taken on merit, exparte. The respondent PIO is also at liberty to file additional submissions, if any, before the next date of hearing."
