It is also appropriate to mention that the complaint of the appellant is of year 2021 and it appears that no action has been taken by the investigation agency i.e. Punjab Police till date and said to be under investigation.
5. Also, in the **'Larger Public Interest'** a copy of this file is **being sent** to the Additional Chief Secretary, Housing and Urban Development, Sector 9, Chandigarh for information and further necessary action as the matter relates to GLADA. As such, the case is **disposed of & closed**.
