ORDER

The RTI application is dated 23.11.2024 whereby the information-seeker has sought information as mentioned in his RTI application. He filed complaint in the Commission under Section 18 of the Right to Information Act, 2005 (hereinafter RTI Act).

2. Notice was issued to the parties for hearing for 05.05.2026 in the Commission.
3. The complainant is absent today. He has sent an email stating that he is unable to attend today's hearing and that his case be heard through Video-conferencing.
4. The respondent states that the information sought by the complainant is not covered u/s 2(f) of the RTI Act.
5. The perusal of the case file shows that the complainant through his RTI application dated 23.11.2024 has sought certain information, as under:-

"There is substantial percentage of population who is diabetic in Punjab. When they get hospitalized in government or private hospital they are not in control or incapacitated to get the food that is suitable for diabetic patients. They get the normal food which increases the complications of the diabetic patients. Because I am also diabetic therefore I am affected by above mention problem of diabetics as in future I may become victim of above mention lapses of food distribution to the hospitalized patients. Therefore please inform under Section 4(1)(d) your administrative reasons of not ordering to government and private hospitals to mandatorily make available without spices boiled vegetables and boiled Dal without Tadka and other food items for diabetics."



COMPLAINT CASE NO.169 OF 2025

The respondent had sent their reply to the complainant on 03.12.2024 mentioning as under:-

“ਆਪ ਵੱਲੋਂ ਮੰਗੀ ਸੂਚਨਾ ਆਰ.ਟੀ.ਆਈ ਐਕਟ 2005 ਦੇ ਸੈਕਸ਼ਨ 2(f),2(j) ਅਧੀਨ ਨਹੀਂ ਆਉਂਦੀ ਹੈ”

Keeping in view the facts of the case and submission made by the respondent, the Commission is of the view that an appropriate response as per the provisions of the RTI Act, 2005 has been provided within the stipulated time period.

6. It is also observed that the complainant has approached the Commission under the provision of Section 18 of the RTI Act, 2005, no directions for providing further information can be given by the Commission. The complainant may take note that in the complaint cases, it is to be seen whether the intention of the respondent-PIO is clear or not.

The attention of the Complainant is also drawn to the decision of the judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India rendered on 12.12.201 in Civil Appeal Nos. Nos.10787 – 10788 of 2011 (arising out of SLP © No.32768-32769/2010)- Chief Information Commissioner and another Vs. State of Manipur and another, in Para 31 whereof, it has been held that while entertaining a complaint case under Section 18 of the RTI Act , 2005, the Commissioners have no jurisdiction to pass an order providing for an access to the information which is as under:-

(31. We uphold the said contention and do not find any error in the impugned judgment of the High Court whereby it has been held that the Commissioner while entertaining a complaint under Section 18 of the said Act has no jurisdiction to pass an order providing for access to the information).

7. In the light of the above observations, the Commission is of the view that there is no mala fide denial of information on the part of the concerned PIO and hence no action is required to be taken in this case. Therefore, no further intervention of the Commission is required in the instant Complaint case. Hence, the complaint case filed by the complainant is disposed of and closed. Copy of the orders be sent to the parties. *However, the complainant is given a liberty to file Second appeal in the Commission , if he wishes to.*
