3. The appellant alleged that the Panchayati land has been exchanged by Sh. Gurdev Singh, Patwariillegally and requested to supply the information.

4. The respondent submitted a copy of order of the Director, Consolidation(chakbandi)(ਚੱਕਬੰਦੀ) with regard to the Land exchanged between Sh. Gurdev Singh, Patwari& others (Land 26 canal, 6 Marla) with the Panchayati Land measuring 154 canal, 10 Marla vide intkal no. 1722.The respondent handed over a copy of this order to the appellant during the course of hearing. Regarding the remaining information i.e. a copy of panchayat proceeding, the respondent submits that the same will be supplied to the appellant as the said record is not traceable. He further submits that in case the said proceeding of the panchayat is not available on record then the specific undertaking will be sent to the appellant within one month with a copy to the Commission. Also, he tenders conditional apology and requested to withdraw the show cause notice issued in this case. Keeping in view the submissions made by the respondent, after consideration, the show cause notice issued to Sh. Kulwinder Singh, NaibTehsildar, is hereby withdrawn.

5. Since, the major chunk of the Panchayat Land measuring 154 canal, 10 Marla has been exchanged with the land of the individual Patwari, Sh. Gurdev Singh measuring 26 canal, 6 Marla, therefore, a copy of this order is **being sent** to the Financial Commissioner, Revenue to look into the matter and take appropriate action as per the procedure established by Law. A copy of the order of Director Consolidation, (Chakbandi) (ਚੱਕਬੰਦੀ) along with the information supplied is attached herewith as it appears that the exchange of land is not in accordance with the law. He is at liberty to call for such record in which the land has been/is being exchanged in the State of Punjab.

6. Keeping in view the above, the Commission is of the view that no further action is required to be taken in this case. Therefore, this case is **disposed of & closed**.

3. The appellant submits that the directions may be issued to the respondent to supply the complete information in this case. However, the respondent submits that the complete information as available on record has already been supplied to the appellant in a case filed by the appellant bearing no. AC: 4282 of 2023. He further submits that he has mislead the Commission by filing the similar RTI application in this case i.e. AC:6192 of 2023. He has also submitted a copy of the order passed by the Information Commission in AC:4282 of 2023, which has already been disposed of, the relevant portion of which is as follows:

"2. The appellant is not present today.

3. The respondent has filed his reply today, pertaining to the RTI of the appellant as under:

4. The perusal of the case file shows that the appellant is not present today. He was not present on the previous date of hearing also. He has not even bothered to inform the Commission about his absence. Further, the

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respondent has filed his reply which appears to be convincing. Hence, no further cause of action is left. Therefore, the appeal case filed by the appellant is disposed off and closed. However, the copy of information, as filed by the respondent, is sent to the appellant with these orders. Copy of the orders be sent to the parties.”

4. It is also a fact that the appellant given a certificate that no decision has been taken by the

Commission. The relevant portion of the certificate given by the appellant in this case is as follows:

5. It is also a fact that the appellant filed two cases in the commission against the one RTI application to the Public Information Officer as in both the cases, the request of the appellant is of dated 08.04.2023 and the fee of the RTI application was paid vide IPO No. 60F838607 that too remained the same in both the cases, which appears that he has filed the two cases intentionally and willfully.

6. From the perusal of the certificate given by the appellant and the sought information, the Act and conduct of the appellant is not sustainable in the eyes of Law. Although, it is a legal right of the appellant to get the information under the RTI Act, 2005 but there are his duties so that there should not be a burden on the state exchequer. In light of the above, the

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appellant is debarred for 180 days from the issue of this order for filing another case(s).As such, a copy of this order is being sent to the Registry Branch for information and further necessary action.
