- 3. However, the respondent reiterated the submissions already made vide letter dated 10.12.2024. On asking particularly, the respondent submitted the specific link of the website on which the information related to three categories is available on the website i. e. Regularised Colonies List, Applied Unauthorized Colonies and Survey of Unauthorized Colonies and the links are as follows:

He also categorically submitted that no survey of Unauthorized Colonies is available on record except pertaining to year 2018, link of which has already been submitted, mentioned herein.

- 4. Furthermore, the respondent submits that nothing more is available with the department which could be supplied to the appellant and requested to close the case. So far as the information is concerned, no further directions can be given to the respondent as the respondent categorically made the submissions that nothing more is available on record which could be supplied especially when the respondent disseminated the information on the website in compliance with Section 4 of the RTI Act, 2005.
- 5. The mandate of the RTI Act is transparency and accountability in the functioning of the public authority. It is an astonishing fact that the department conducted the survey with regard to unauthorized colonies during 2018 which is available on the website, which transpires that thereafter no survey has been conducted till date. According to the RTI application, it appears that there are illegal industrial colonies in the area of Bhamian Kalan, Ludhiana (East) and there may be industries which are running with and/or without NOC/CLU in illegal colonies
