2. The appellant is absent without intimation for the second consecutive hearing of this appeal case. It is also a fact that copy of previous order was sent to him through registered post but even though he is absent, which seems his absence is intentional and willful. The appellant has not submitted any written submission and nor has he opted to be present at today's hearing, which appears that either he has nothing to say in this case and/or does not intend to pursue the case.

3. The respondent is absent, but an email dated 15.07.2025, has been received from him mentioning therein that the complete sought information has already been supplied to the appellant. Further, he also submitted an apology letter from the PIO, Office of the EO, Nagar Council, Mansa, vide letter dated 24.07.2025. The letter explained that the delay occurred due to staff shortages and an excessive workload. The PIO assured that such delays would not recur and requested the Commission to waive the penalty of Rs. 10,000.00 (imposed on PIO vide Order dated 11.05.2023) and dispose of the case.

4. After considering the above facts it noted that the RTI application has been adequately addressed, and sufficient hearings have been conducted to consider this case. Moreover, the Commission issue a warning to the PIO to handle RTI applications promptly and to avoid delays in the future and accordingly, the penalty is hereby **dropped**.

5. In view of the above, and considering the over-pendency of cases in the Commission, the case is **disposed of and closed**. Copy of the order be sent to the parties.

2. Shri Santosh Kumar, is present on behalf of the appellant and states that no information has been given to him so far.

3. The respondent PIO-cum-EO, Shri Manpreet Singh, states that the information sought by the appellant in this RTI application is identical / similar to that already supplied to him in Complaint Case No. 234 of 2023, which was disposed of by the bench of former SIC, Shri Amrit Partap Singh Sekhon. Further, the respondent tenders unconditional apology regarding delay occurred in this case and made oral submissions in this regard.
