ORDER:

The RTI application is dated **30.08.2025** vide which the appellant had sought the information as enumerated in his RTI application. First Appeal was filed with the First Appellate Authority (FAA) on **01.11.2025** and Second Appeal was filed in the Commission on **06.04.2026** under Section 19 of the Right to Information Act, 2005 (hereinafter RTI Act). Notice of hearing was issued to the parties for today i.e. **17.09.2026**.

2. The appellant, Shri Bharat Sharma, attended the hearing via mobile phone and states that no information has been given to him so far.

3. The respondent PIO, represented by ASI Sardul Singh, states that the Peer Baba Zinda Shaheed Committee, Nurpur Bedi, is not a Public Authority as defined under Section 2(h) of the RTI Act, 2005. Further, the respondent clarified that the Committee received no financial grants or funding from the Government and submits his reply via email dated 16.09.2026, which is taken on record.

4. The Commission concurs with the respondent that the Peer Baba Zinda Shaheed Committee, Nurpur Bedi, cited in the RTI application is not a Public Authority as defined by the RTI Act, 2005, it falls outside the purview of the Act.

5. The decision of the respondent PIO is herewith upheld. In view of the above, the Commission is of the view that no further action is required to be taken in this case. Therefore, this case is **disposed of and closed**. Copy of the order be sent to the parties.
