ORDER:

- 1. The appellant has filed the present appeal before the Commission, and the matter has been fixed for hearing today.
- 2. During the hearing, the Respondent, Sh. Jagwant Singh, Panchayat Secretary, submitted that an amount of Rs. 4,900/- towards documentation fee was demanded from the appellant within 30 days, but the same was not deposited. ORDER:

- 1. The above seven complaint cases filed by the Complainant were taken up together as the issues involved are similar; therefore, a single interim order is being passed to avoid duplication of proceedings and to ensure consistency in adjudication. The Complainant appeared and submitted that he has already filed his detailed written submissions and the same may kindly be taken as his separate submission in each of the seven cases. The request is accepted and his written submissions are taken on record accordingly.
- 2. The Complainant has objected to the appearance of Adv. Sh. Gulshan Mehta on behalf of the Respondent PIO. The Complainant has further contended that these proceedings are complaints under Section 18 of the RTI Act, 2005 and he is seeking imposition of penalty under Section 20(1) and initiation of disciplinary action under Section 20(2) against the Respondent PIO for alleged malafide denial and habitual non-compliance. He has clarified that he is not seeking supply of information but punitive action only. He has also asserted that the information sought by him is connected with larger public interest.
- 3. On the other hand, Adv. Gulshan Mehta has filed a memo of appearance in all seven cases on behalf of the Respondent PIO and submitted written arguments. He submits that the RTI applications filed by the Complainant seek extremely voluminous, nonspecific and wide-ranging information covering the entire record of the public authority,

including internal vetting processes, measurement books, resolutions, bills and other related documents, including information belonging to third parties. He contends that collection and compilation of such information would **disproportionately divert the resources** of the Municipal Council and is therefore hit by Section 7(9) of the RTI Act. He has relied upon the judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in *CBSE v. AdityaBandopadhyay* (Civil Appeal No. 6454/2011). He has also stated that the Complainant has submitted multiple RTI applications seeking similarly voluminous information.

- 4. The memo of appearance filed by Adv. Sh. Gulshan Mehta in these seven connected complaint cases is taken on record and accepted for the purpose of representing the Respondent PIO, without prejudice to the objections raised by the Complainant, which shall be decided at the stage of final order.
- 5. In view of the rival contentions, the Commission is of the opinion that before passing a final order, **both parties must file specific rejoinders**on the issues raised, namely:
 - (i) The applicability and scope of Section 18 jurisdiction in the present cases;
 - (ii) The Complainant's objections regarding representation by counsel;
 - (iii) The Respondent PIO's justification for the alleged denial of information, including reliance upon Section 7(9) and other statutory grounds;
 - (iv) The Complainant's claim of larger public interest involved;
 - (v) The question of whether the circumstances attract action under **Section 20(1) and 20(2)** of the RTI Act.
- 6. Accordingly, **both parties are granted 15 days' time** from the date of this order reciptto file their rejoinders/submissions, case-wise, addressing the above points. The same shall reach the Commission before the next date of hearing, failing which **the Commission shall proceed on the basis of the available record**.
- 7. The **final order** in all seven complaint cases shall be passed only after consideration of the rejoinders filed by both parties.
