ORDER:

The application dated **07.11.2022** vide which the complainant has sought information as enumerated in her RTI application. Complaint was filed in the Commission on **31.05.2023** under Section 18 of the Right to Information Act, 2005 (hereinafter RTI Act). Notice of hearing was issued to the parties for today i.e. **20.11.2024**.

- 2. The complainant states that his essential purpose is to obtain the demanded information as mentioned in his RTI application. However, the respondent is not present. It is also a fact that notice of the hearing which was sent to him received back by the Commission with the remarks 'Insufficient Address'.
- 3. As the complainant is interested to collect/get the sought information. It is appropriate to mention that Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in its order rendered on 12.12.2011 in Civil Appeal Nos.10787 10788 of 2011 (arising out of SLP © No.32768- 32769/2010) has held that while entertaining a complaint under Section 18 of the RTI Act, 2005, the Commissioners have no jurisdiction to pass an order providing for an access to the information. Since the complainant has approached the Commission under the provisions of Section 18 of the RTI Act, 2005, no directions for providing further information can be given by the Commission.

Since, an alternative and efficacious remedy of first appeal is available to the complainant who is interested in getting the information, accordingly, without going into the merits of the case, the case is remanded back to the <u>First Appellate Authority i.e. O/o Principal Secretary, Transport Department, Punjab Civil Secretariat 2, Sector -9, Chandigarh</u>, to take appropriate decision in accordance with the provisions of the RTI Act, 2005, within the prescribed timeline, after giving opportunity of hearing to all concerned by passing a speaking order.
- 5. With these directions, the case is <u>disposed of and closed</u>. However, the liberty is granted to the complainant to file second appeal, if he is not satisfied/does not receive the decision of the First Appellate Authority.
