ORDER:

It is also a fact that notice of hearing was sent to him through registered post even then he is absent, which seems his absence is intentional and willful. The prima facie appears that the appellant does not intends to pursue the case and he has nothing to say in this regard.

4. After having the detailed deliberations with the respondent and examining the reply filed by the respondent, the Commission is of the view that no further cause of action is required in this case. Hence, this case is **disposed off and closed.**

ORDER:

This order may be read with the reference to the previous orders dated **14.12.2022**, **14.02.2023**, **19.04.2023**, and **07.06.2023** passed by Former SIC, Sh. Anumit Singh Sodhi, State Information Commissioner, Punjab, who has demitted the office on **20.10.2023**., thereafter, the case was allocated to the undersigned bench. Notice of hearing was issued to the parties for today i.e. **21.01.2025**.

2. The appellant is absent, but a letter has been received in the Commission vide diary no. 1142 dated 21.01.2025, mentioning therein, he has received incomplete information from the respondent, which is taken on record.
