ORDER:

This order may be read with the reference to the previous order dated **19.08.2025**.

2. The appellant, Shri Sudhir Chadha, states that no information has been given to him so far. He also requests that the respondent be penalised for the delay in providing the information.

3. The respondent is absent without intimation for the second consecutive hearing of this appeal case, which shows his carelessness and casual attitude towards the orders of the Commission. The respondent **PIO O/o Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana**, is herewith ordered to **SHOW CAUSE** as to why a penalty should not be imposed upon him under Section 20 (1) of RTI Act, 2005, for causing willful delay/denial of the information requested by the appellant as far back as on **01.04.2022**. **If there is / are other PIO / PIOs responsible for the delay in providing the information, the incumbent PIO is directed to inform such PIO(s) of the Show Cause and direct them to appear before the Commission along with written replies.**

"In addition to the written reply, the respondent PIO is also given an opportunity under Section 20 (1) provision there to, for a personal hearing before the imposition of such penalty on the next date of hearing. He may take note that in case he does not file his written reply and does not avail himself of the opportunity of personal hearing on the date fixed, it will be presumed that he has nothing to say and the Commission shall proceed to take further proceedings against him *ex parte*." Copies of this order be sent to the parties through registered post.

ORDER:

The RTI application is dated **05.07.2023** vide which the appellant has sought the information as enumerated in his RTI application.
