Hon'ble Supreme Court categorically held (Para 31 and 32 of the judgment) that Information Commissioners, while entertaining a Complaint under Section 18 has no jurisdiction to pass an order providing for access to information. It was held that the remedy for such a person, who has been refused information, is provided under Section 19 of the Act. The SC further directed (Para 44 of the judgment) the appellant to file appeal under Section 19 of the Act in respect of his two RTI requests for obtaining information. order providing for access to information. The present Complainant having moved an application under Section 18 of the Act ibid erroneously expects the Commission to direct the respondent for disclosure of information, in the present review petition....".
