- 1. The RTI application is dated 15.03.2024 vide which the appellant has sought information as enumerated in his RTI application. First appeal was filed with the First Appellate Authority (hereinafter FAA) on 16.04.2024 and the second appeal was filed in the Commission on 04.06.2024 under Section 19 of the Right to Information Act, 2005 (hereinafter RTI Act). Notice of hearing was issued to the parties for today i.e.28.10.2025.
- 2. The appellant stats that after the lapse of one year, no reply/information has been provided to him by the respondent PIO and requested that directions be issued to the respondent PIO to provide the sought for information.
- 3. Neither the respondent nor any of his representative is absent at today's hearing. They have also not sent any intimation regarding their non-availability, which shows carelessness and irresponsible attitude towards the order of the Commission.
- 4. The Commission takes an adverse view of the inaction upon the part of the PIO in not providing the information sought for within the stipulated time, thereby, deliberately delaying furnishing of information to the appellant. In the interest of natural justice, **one more opportunity** is granted to the respondent PIO to appear in person in the Commission at Chandigarh along with the point wise written reply and provide the requisite information to the appellant, before the next date of hearing, under intimation to the Commission. Failure to attend the Hearing will compel the Commission to ensure their presence through service of a **Bailable Warrant**.
