ORDER:

The RTI application is dated **15.11.2023** vide which the appellant has sought the information as enumerated in his RTI application. First Appeal was filed with the First Appellate Authority (FAA) on **02.01.2024** and Second Appeal was filed in the Commission on **18.03.2024** under Section 19 of the Right to Information Act, 2005 (hereinafter RTI Act). Notice of hearing was issued to the parties for today i.e. **20.09.2025**.

2. The appellant states that the reply given by the respondent is misleading as he has not received any information till date.

3. The respondent PIO, represented by Senior Constable Harpreet Singh, files a reply to the Commission's Notice of Hearing vide letter dated 26.09.2025 mentioning therein that the sought information is exempt under section 8(1)(g) of the RTI Act, 2005. Copy of the same is taken on record.

4. After having detailed deliberations with both the parties and examining the case file, the Commission is of the view that sought information is not exempted as per RTI Act, 2005. This is the first hearing before the undersigned, hence in the interest of justice, respondent PIO is awarded **one last opportunity** to provide the appellant complete requisite information, duly attested, free of cost, through registered post, in accordance with his RTI application dated 15.11.2023 and present a photocopy of the relevant postal receipt along with a copy of the information provided, before the Commission on the next date fixed, for its perusal and records.
