ORDER

This order may be read with reference to the previous order dated 23.06.2026 vide which the appellant was given an opportunity to point out deficiencies in the information provided.

2. The appellant is not present today. However, he has sent an e-mail through which he has sought an adjournment from today's hearing. Further, he has also intimated that he has already pointed out the deficiencies to the respondent but the complete information has not been provided to him. He has also filed copy of the deficiencies sent to the respondent.

3. The respondent states that the information has been provided to the appellant.

4. The perusal of the case file shows that the respondent had provided the information running into 173 pages to the appellant. The appellant has submitted that he had already pointed out the deficiencies and that the information supplied by the respondent continues to be incomplete. He has also forwarded written submissions through e-mail, which have been taken on record. The Commission has carefully perused the said submissions. However, the contents thereof are neither in the nature of a proper rejoinder to the respondent's reply nor do they clearly indicate the specific deficiencies which allegedly continue to persist. The submissions are vague and repetitive in nature and do not meaningfully assist the Commission in determining the exact information which, according to the appellant, remains undisclosed.

5. The Commission is of the considered view that proceedings under the RTI Act cannot be permitted to continue indefinitely merely on account of generalized allegations regarding incomplete information. Once the respondent has furnished a detailed response and the appellant

has failed to specifically demonstrate, despite repeated opportunities, as to which information continues to be withheld, no useful purpose would be served by keeping the matter pending any further.

6. The Commission further observes that the appellant has been asserting that the information supplied is deficient; however, despite being granted adequate opportunity, he has failed to place before the Commission a clear, specific and cogent rejoinder identifying the precise deficiencies which continue to survive after receipt of the respondent's point-wise reply. Such conduct has unnecessarily prolonged the adjudication of the present appeal.

7. In view of the foregoing discussion and the material available on record, the Commission finds no ground warranting further intervention in the matter. Therefore, the appeal case filed by the appellant is **disposed of and closed**. Copy of the orders be sent to the parties.

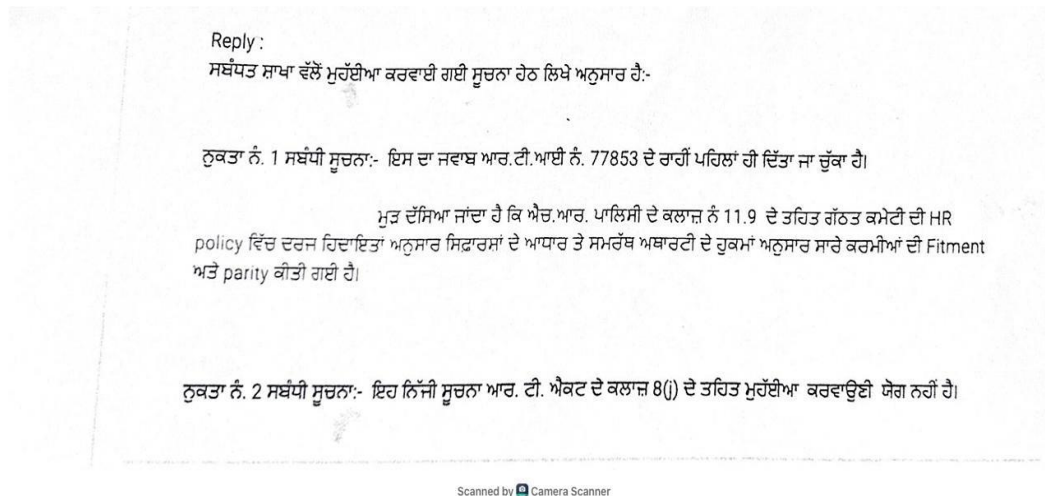
